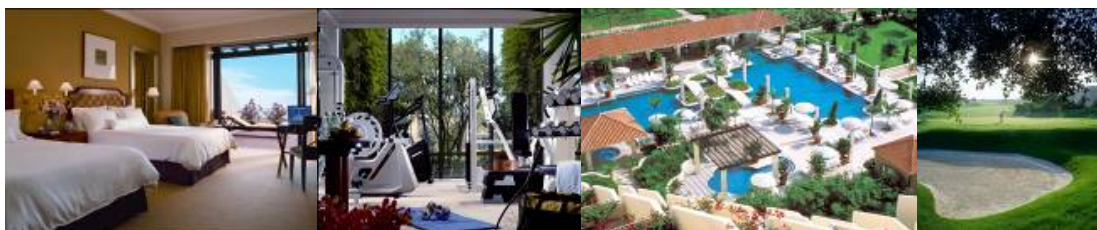
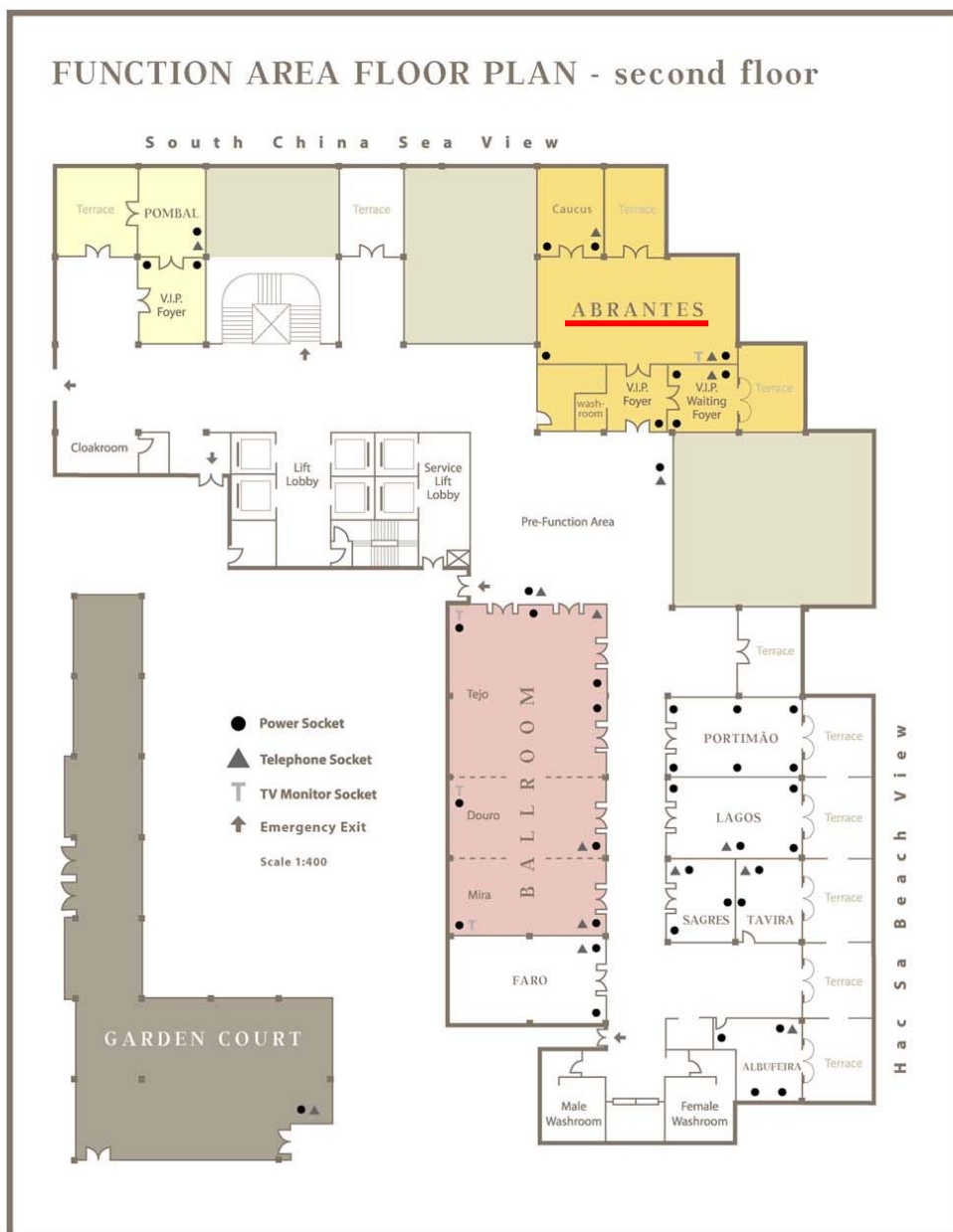

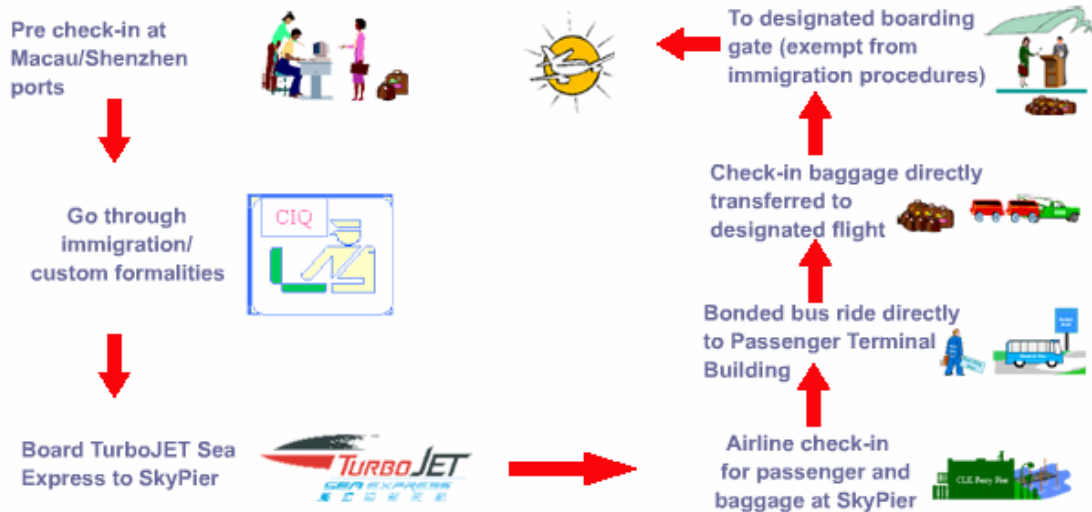
Guests are recommended to take the TurboJET Sea Express from the Hong Kong International Airport to Macau. To take TurboJET Sea Express, you may proceed to the Air/Sea Transfer Desk located at E1 area, Level 5, Passenger Terminal Building right after arrival. There is no need to go through the immigration. Your checked baggage will also be identified and transferred to the pier. Valid ferry ticket can be purchased at the counter and shuttle bus service will be provided for Sea Express passengers to the pier at W1. You are required to arrive to the pier service counter *60 minutes* (with checked baggage) OR *30 minutes* before sailing time (without checked baggage or with airline tag through baggage).
